### Pay to Play Politics

Sue Lee has a disturbing record of accepting campaign contributions from developers and special interests whose projects she voted on as a Planning Commissioner.<sup>1</sup> According to the San Francisco Ethics Commission, Lee has already accepted thousands of dollars in these questionable donations...and counting.

### Bankrolled by Downtown

Developers, consultants, lobbyists, real estate speculators and other downtown interests have already poured \$36,325<sup>2</sup> directly into Lee's campaign. Even worse, they've spent over \$29,292<sup>3</sup> in shadow organizations backing Lee and attacking independent candidates.
