ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Brought about a significant decline in violent crime with foot patrols and community policing

- Authored landmark laws on climate protection, a plastic bag ban and mass transit commuter benefits
- Stopped unjust school closures and revived parent-teacher associations
- Sponsored legislation that opposed the spraying of pesticides to eradicate the light brown apple moth
- Shepherded the passage of the 55 Laguna project (dedicated LGBT senior housing) and the Market-Octavia project (the city’s largest mixed-use affordable housing development in 20 years)
- Successfully defended against the closure of mental health beds at San Francisco General Hospital

IMPROVING JOBS

- Revamp our city’s employment programs, including job training and placement
- Mandate commuter checks for workers who use public transportation

FIGHTING FOR EDUCATION

- Ensure schools have the funding they need to stay open and serve our kids
- Improve family and community partnerships with schools

PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT AND THE PUBLIC HEALTH

- Push San Francisco to generate its own power from alternative energy sources and make the city energy independent
- Fight the building of fossil fuel-dependent power plants in the city
- Advocate for improved public transit options to get cars off the road, decrease oil consumption and make the city safer for bicycles and pedestrians
