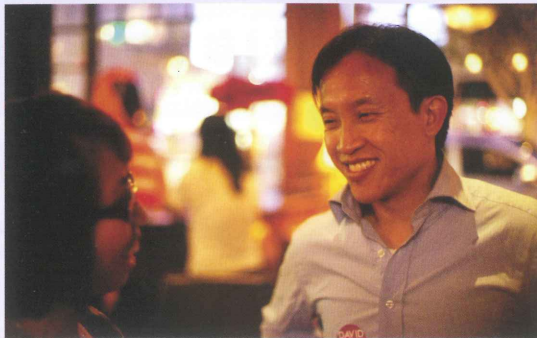

- Advocated for new recreational facilities and new libraries.
- Strengthened rent control and protections for tenants.

- Fought to create thousands of jobs and attract billions of dollars of economy activity with Hunters Point Shipyard, America's Cup, Treasure Island, and other projects.
- Led efforts to keep Twitter and other high-growth, job-creating businesses in San Francisco.
- Cut dozens of unnecessary fees that were nickling and diming local small businesses.

A Leader In Improving City Services

- Supported more city resources to improving our public schools.
- Tackled mismanagement at Muni and fought to restore service cuts.
- Supported community policing and the creation of the Community Ambassadors program.
- Made city services more language accessible for immigrant communities.

A Reformer Who Cleans Up City Hall

- Reformed the budget process to require long-term financial planning and savings.
- Passed tough ethics legislation to hold lobbyists and city officials accountable.
